Are You Ready for Kindergarten (all children entering Kindergarten in September 2017)

- o **Language Processing**: Language Processing Disorder affect expressive language (what you say) and/or receptive language (how you understand what others say).
- o **Printing Skills**: Learn tips and tricks to improve printing skills, neatness & legibility.
- o **Executive Functioning**: These skills are the mental processes that enable us to plan, focus attention, remember instructions, and juggle multiple tasks successfully.
- o **Reading:** Learn tools that can be used at home to improve your child's reading skills.
- o **Let's Move**: Learn how to encourage your child to move on the playground and at home to build strength and coordination.
