### **Field Trip to Metis Crossing**

All of our VES students and staff will be participating in a school program celebrating Métis contributions to Canada. The program makes curricular connections to the Métis story, way of life and their role in shaping present day Canada outside of a traditional classroom setting.

June 8th - 3/4, 4B, 5A, 5/6, 6 Classes June 9th- 1A, 1B, 2A, 2B, 3A Classes

### Stations

**Buffalo Camp -** Learn how the Buffalo and the laws of the hunt shaped the Métis Nation. Sample some dried Buffalo and taste one of the most important pieces to their diet.

**Metis History Walk -** Learn about the significant history of Métis Crossing, learn about and identify some common plants and visit the historical village and see what a traditional home on a river lot looked like.

Metis Art - Stop in at the Red barn to learn about Métis art and make your own beaded keychain or finger weave a small sash.

Traditional Games - Work as a team to master some traditional Métis games.



# What is Lemonade Day?

Lemonade Day is a free, fun, experiential learning program that teaches youth, Kindergarten to high school, how to start, own and operate their own business – a lemonade stand.

Along the way, kids acquire skills in goal-setting, problem solving, and gain self-esteem critical for future success, all while having FUN!

### When is it?

Lemonade Day for Northern Alberta is on Saturday June 17, 2023

# Who can participate?

Youth of all ages, from **Kindergarten through High School**, can register to participate in
Lemonade Day.

Registration opens on March 1, 2023 and will close June 1, 2023.

### How does Lemonade Day work?

Once a child has registered for Lemonade Day, they will then pick a location to attend Lemonade University.

At University each child receives a backpack with an Entrepreneur Workbook where they learn the lessons of Lemonade Day. Our facilitator will guide them through the workbook where they will learn skills like creating budgets, setting profit-making goals, serving customers, repaying investors, and giving back to the community.

After attending Lemmy U kids are eligible to enter their area's "Best Tasting Lemonade Contest" if they choose.

Then on June 17, 2023 all participants will set up their Lemonade Stands in their towns and try their hand at running their own business. On that day they can also enter in their areas "Best Lemonade Stand Contest" as well as the "Best Entrepreneur Contest".

Kids who participate in Lemonade Day keep all the profit their stands make, but the program encourages them to save some, spend some and share some.

Once Lemonade Day is over kids can then enter their business results on the Lemonade day Northern Alberta website and they will be entered to WIN a New Bike.
