 - Gaps from COVID are closing, Alberta assessments in reading and numeracy, low percentage of not at risk, little bit higher in numeracy in gaps (in particular grade 4, 5 and 6)
 - Carmen Throndson going on Maternity leave, interviews next week
 - o Book fair November 20-23rd
 - Fundraiser to acquire new books, making sure they have books to represent
 - AR books selected by students who earn points by end of first term
 - o Parent teacher interviews November 22-23rd
 - School council grant, will review next meeting
 - Saturday, free webinar, school council from 1-4pm, Facebook on Alberta School Council
