














Children learn by observing adults model and demonstrate empathy in veryday interactions. Top Tips to Teach Empathy Acknowledge and Name Emotions Together Top Tips to Teach Empathy Encourage "Perspective Taking" When emotions run high—whether it's anger, sadness, or excitement—practice naming the emotions together i.e..) "It seems like you're feeling really disappointed right now." By helping children recognize and name their emotions, they become better at understanding feelings.
