Vermilion Elementary School Lunch Society

The VES Lunch Society is excited to begin a new year of hot and nutritious lunches. Here are some instructions for using the meal ordering website, same instructions for both new and returning families. Everyone needs to newly register each fall so that students can be efficiently placed in their new classroom. It is called Hotlunches.net. Ordering online helps ensure accuracy and to make the process as easy for everyone as possible. Here's how to get started...

- Go to VES.hotlunches.net
- Click on "Click Here to Register" (It's on the bottom right of screen)
- · Click on "parent" as user type
- Enter Access Code VEHL
- Complete the rest of the registration form, using your name, not your child's name. (Including
 your email address will ensure you receive reminder emails about hot lunch order deadlines, and
 your child's hot lunch order for the upcoming week). As well, your email address will now be
 your username.
- Choose one of your children's teachers names from the drop down menu, then enter one child's name (don't use guest)
- · Click the "Register Now" button at the bottom
- On the welcome screen click "Profile" then "add students" to enter your other student's details including home room. Do this for each student that you have that attends Vermilion Elementary School.
- Proceed to order hot lunch for your child(ren)


The hot lunch online ordering system requires a small amount of setup time at the beginning as you must register each child you have attending our school prior to ordering hot lunch. Once the initial setup process is complete, your hot lunch orders for the remainder of the year should be quick and simple.

Payment: We are encouraging everyone to pay online or by etransfer. We will still accept cash/cheque inside a labelled envelope at the school. Cheques are only cashed once per month, typically between the 21st to the 26th. If you pay online there will be an additional 2.4% added to your payment to cover this convenience.


